BULLETIN 1

The Executive Committee (EC) of the International School Sport Federation ISF has decided to entrust the organisation of the **World Schools Ski Championship** 2010 to Folgaria, Lavarone, Luserna/ITALY.

1. INVITATIONS

Invitations to participate in the World Championship are being sent to school sport organisations which are full or associate members of ISF and for information to members of the ISF EC, to members of the ISF Ski Technical Commission and to the International Ski Federation (FIS).

2. COMPOSITION OF TEAMS AND RULES FOR PARTICIPATION

2.1 School teams can participate at the event.

There will be a competition organised in the following categories:

School teams, boys Alpine skiing	category 1 + 2
School teams, girls Alpine skiing	category 1 + 2
School teams, boys Nordic skiing	category 1 + 2
School teams, girls Nordic skiing	category 1 + 2

2.2 All students in the boy-school team must have been enrolled at the same school since the beginning of the school year 2009/2010

All students in the girls-school team must have been enrolled at the same school since the beginning of the school year 2009/2010

2.3 Each student may only run in one team.

2.4 Students must have been born in
Category 1: born (1997)/96/95
Category 2: born (1995)/94/93

Neither older nor younger students will be accepted!

2.4 Each team shall be composed of 5 runners and 1 teacher/coach.
Each Alpine delegation and each Nordic delegation shall nominate a Head of Delegation who shall be responsible for the team or teams in his/her delegation. They may not combine the functions of head of delegation and coach.

Thus a full delegation will comprise at maximum 50 persons.

Delegation size:

- 1 Head of Alpine Delegation
- 1 Head of Nordic Delegation
- 8 teachers/coaches
- 40 competitors

2.5 Each participating country has the right to include a maximum of 2 additional adults whose function must be specified: doctor, physiotherapist, interpreter, security personnel, ministerial representative, journalist.....

Any other additional person will not be considered part of the official delegation and will not be accredited by the OC.

2.6 Participants must be enrolled as full-time students at the school which they represent. They must be attending schools which provide a general education (General Competition Rules GCR - 7.3)

The following are not eligible to participate (GCR - 7.7):

- a) pupils of vocational schools who only attend that school as a complement to their vocational training;
- b) school teams and pupils enrolled at schools which provide sports training without any general education;
- c) part-time (e.g. afternoon) sports schools which take pupils from a variety of schools for training in one or more sports;
- d) teams formed as part of clubs, companies, universities or other institutions.

2.7 Each participating team must be nominated officially by the organisation responsible for school sport and which is a member of ISF. The teams enrolled by the Head of the school won't be accepted in the competition.

3. PROVISIONAL PROGRAMME

Tuesday, 2 March	Training Team-Captains-Meeting Opening Ceremony and Prologue (Category 2 Nordic)

Wednesday, 3 March	Competition «Meeting of the Nations» Evening
Thursday, 4 March	Training Team-Captains-Meeting Friendship day
Friday, 5 March	Competition Prize-giving (medals & trophies), Closing Ceremony & Farewell Party
Saturday, 6 March	Delegations depart

4. TRAVEL

Travel as far as **Verona** international airport or **Rovereto** railway station (HST) is to be arranged and financed by each participating country.

5. FEES AND INSURANCE

- 5.1 In return for the entry fees which are fixed by the ISF Executive Committee, the Organising Committee will be responsible for board and lodging for participants for the duration of the championships, for the competition and cultural programme activities and for all transport in connection with the official programme (arrival, departure, sports and cultural programmes).
- 5.2 In accordance with the rules laid down by ISF, the payment to be made to the organisers of the World Championship amount to 42 EUR per person and per night for a maximum of 50 persons.

An additional ISF levy of 25 EUR per delegation member will be collected at the time of registration.

The total sum per person is therefore 235 EUR (5 x 42 EUR + 25 EUR).

When the distance between FOLGARIA and the capital of a participating country on another continent exceeds 5000 kilometres the delegation may extend its stay by arriving one day earlier **or** leaving one day later at the normal daily fee (42 EUR).

- 5.3 For two supplementary adults the following regulation applies:
- For a single room 84 EUR per night
 - For a double/twin room (2 additional persons) 42 EUR per night each
 - For a double/twin room (1 additional person + 1 teacher) 42 EUR per night each

Requests are to be made by the country concerned.

- 5.4 If the delegation travels by bus, the driver of the bus will be considered as a member of the delegation and will be charged 42 EUR per night.

- 5.5 The organisation of an extended stay for the delegation (before or after the event) is a matter for the country concerned. It shall not be the responsibility of the Organising Committee.
- 5.6 Each country is required to provide insurance for each member of its delegation. At a minimum the insurance is to cover civil liability, material damage and medical costs.

6. DEPOSIT

- 6.1 Along with the entry, each country must pay a deposit of 84 EUR per person as confirmation of the entry.

The deposit must be sent **as a single payment for the whole delegation** by the organisation responsible for school sport (federation, trust, ministry...) Payments made by individual schools will not be accepted.

The sum of the deposit will be deducted from the total cost of participation.

This deposit is non-refundable in the event of non-participation unless the delegation has informed the organisers before the draw/starting list or in the case of force majeure. The latter instance will require the approval of the ISF Steering Committee.

- 6.2 The ISF Secretariat is responsible for registering all deposits before 30th November 2009.

- 6.4 The balance in cash in EUROS is to be paid on arrival in FOLGARIA (bank and credit cards will be eventually accepted) or may be paid in EUROS to the organisers' bank account as published in the third bulletin, by 15 February at the latest.
- 6.5 **All bank charges (for both deposit and balance) are to be met by participating countries.**

7. TECHNICAL RULES

7.1 The competition will be run according to current ISF and FIS rules under the direction of the ISF Technical Commission and the FIS (International Ski Federation) for the age group born 1993/94. Competitors who are participating in the FIS-Race have to own a valid FIS-Code-Number.

7.2 Alpine Skiing Competition:

- Giant Slalom 2 runs
- Special Slalom 2 runs

For the Category 2 the homologated competitions will be open to everybody. The FIS-scores will be assigned only to runners owning a FIS-code.

7.3 Nordic Skiing Competition:

- Single run (free style)
Distance: girls category 1 and 2 and boys category 1 => 5 km;
 boys category 2 => 6-8 km.
For the category 2 a prologue + pursuit run will be possible
- Relay race (classic or mixed style)

7.4 The team will be composed of at maximum 5 runners; the minimum is of 3 runners for the Alpine skiing and 4 for the Nordic skiing, + 1 teacher.

7.5 Every country can participate with one female team and one male team for each category of both Alpine and Nordic skiing.

7.6 The teams are composed of students of the same school, except for “flat countries”, for which 5 students from different schools can form the team. Teams from the following list of countries which have unfavourable training conditions may be composed of students from different schools:

Belgium, Cyprus, Denmark, Great Britain, Luxemburg, Netherlands, Hungary.

Other countries with similar conditions, at the discretion of the Technical Commission, be accorded to the same concessions.

8. REGISTRATION

8.1 The entry registration form (see attached) should be duly completed and signed on behalf of the organisation responsible for school sport and returned to the organisers **at the latest by 30th September 2009**:

8.2 The detailed entry bearing the names of all the runners and other members of the delegation is to be returned to the OC by 1st February 2010 (detailed entry forms will be included with Bulletin 3).

9. COMMITMENTS TO BE HONOURED BY DELEGATIONS

- 9.1 Each participant is required to be present throughout the duration of the event.
- 9.2 Each participant is obliged to take part also in all of the non-sport activities.
- 9.3 Each team undertakes to compete against all other participating teams.
- 9.4 Each participant undertakes to compete against all other participants.
- 9.5 The absence of any member of a participating team from any part of the entire sport programme, opening-, prize-giving- and closing ceremonies and socio-cultural programme will result in the team being excluded from the results.

10. DOPING

Dope testing (for use of banned substances) can take place during the competition according to current law/procedures in Italy.

If selected for testing a competitor may be accompanied by an adult. If a competitor is following a course of medical treatment he or she must obtain certification to that effect and inform the organisers immediately upon arrival.
