BULLETIN 1

The Executive Committee (EC) of the International School Sport Federation ISF has decided to entrust the organisation of the **World Schools Orienteering Championship 2011** to Primiero/ Trentino /Italy.

1. INVITATIONS

Invitations to participate in the World Championship are being sent to school sport organisations which are full or associate members of ISF and for information to members of the ISF EC, to members of the ISF Orienteering Technical Commission and to the International Orienteering Federation (IOF).

2. COMPOSITION OF TEAMS AND RULES FOR PARTICIPATION

2.1 The competition is open both to school teams and to selected teams.

In both boys and girls categories a country must have entered a school team before being allowed to enter a selected team in the same category.

There will be a competition organised in the following categories:

School teams, boys	M1 & M2
School teams, girls	W1 & W2
Selected teams, boys	M1 & M2
Selected teams, girls	W1 & W2

2.1.1 All students in the boys school team must have been enrolled at the same school since the beginning of the school year 2010/2011

All students in the girls school team must have been enrolled at the same school since the beginning of the school year 2010/2011

2.1.2 All students of selected teams must have been enrolled at a school in the country concerned since the beginning of the school year 2010/2011

2.2 All students must have been born in 1994, 1995, 1996 or 1997. Neither older nor younger students will be accepted!

M1 boys born in 1994 and 1995
M2 boys born in 1996 and 1997
W1 girls born in 1994 and 1995
W2 girls born in 1996 and 1997

2.3 Each team shall be composed of 5 runners and 1 teacher/coach.

Each delegation shall nominate a Head of Delegation who shall be responsible for the team or teams in his/her delegation. He/she may not combine the functions of head of delegation and coach.

Where a country is represented by only one team, its delegation may comprise up to 7 persons.

A country may enter a maximum of 8 teams (1 school team of girls W1 & 1 school team of girls W2, 1 school team of boys M1 & 1 school team of boys M2, 1 selected team of girls W1 & 1 selected team of girls W2, 1 selected team of boys M1 & 1 selected team of boys M2).

Delegations from countries which enter more than 4 teams may nominate a deputy head of delegation.

Thus a full delegation will comprise 50 persons.

2.4 Each participating country has the right to include a maximum of 2 additional adults whose function must be specified: doctor, physiotherapist, interpreter, security personnel, ministerial representative, journalist.....

Any other additional persons will not be considered part of the official delegation and will not be accredited by the OC.

2.5 Players must be enrolled as full-time students at the school which they represent. They must be attending schools which provide a general education (General Competition Rules GCR - 7.3)

The following are not eligible to participate (GCR - 7.7):

- a) pupils of vocational schools who only attend that school as a complement to their vocational training;
- b) school teams and pupils enrolled at schools which provide sports training without any general education;
- c) part-time (e.g. afternoon) sports schools which take pupils from a variety of schools for training in one or more sports;
- d) teams formed as part of clubs, companies, universities or other institutions.

2.6 Each participating team must be nominated officially by the organisation responsible for school sport and which is a member of ISF.

3. PROVISIONAL PROGRAMME

21 May	Welcome Payment of fees – Accreditation Housing of teams

26 May	Friendship Team Event Prize-giving (medals & trophies), Closing Ceremony & Farewell Party

4. TRAVEL

Travel as far as Venice (Marco Polo) international airport / Treviso international airport / Verona international airport / Trento railway stations, is to be arranged and financed by each participating country.

5. FEES AND INSURANCE

- 5.1 In return for the entry fees which are fixed by the ISF Executive Committee, the Organising Committee will be responsible for board and lodging for participants for the duration of the championships, for the competition and cultural programme activities and for all transport in connection with the official programme (arrival, departure, sports and cultural programmes)
- 5.2 In accordance with the rules laid down by ISF, the payment to be made to the organisers of the World Championship amount to 42 EUR per person and per night for a maximum of 50 persons.

An additional ISF levy of 25 EUR per delegation member will be collected at the time of registration.

The total sum per person is therefore 277 EUR (252 EUR + 25 EUR).

When the distance between TRENTO and the capital of a participating country on another continent exceeds 5000 kilometres the delegation may extend its stay by arriving one day earlier or leaving one day later at the normal daily fee (42 EUR).

- 5.3 For two supplementary adults the following regulation applies:
- For a single room 84 EUR per night
 - For a double/twin room (2 additional persons) 42 EUR per night each
 - For a double/twin room (1 additional person + 1 teacher or 1 referee) 42 EUR per night each
- Requests are to be made by the country concerned.
- 5.4 If the delegation travels by bus, the driver of the bus will be considered as a member of the delegation and will be charged 42 EUR per night.
- 5.5 The organisation of an extended stay for the delegation (before or after the event) is a matter for the country concerned. It shall not be the responsibility of the Organising Committee.
- 5.6 Each country is required to provide insurance for each member of its delegation. At a minimum the insurance is to cover civil liability, material damage and medical costs.

6. DEPOSIT

- 6.1 Along with the entry, each country must pay a deposit of 84 EUR per person as confirmation of the entry.

The deposit must be sent **as a single payment for the whole delegation** by the organisation responsible for school sport (federation, trust, ministry...) Payments made by individual schools will not be accepted.

The sum of the deposit will be deducted from the total cost of participation.

This deposit is non-refundable in the event of non-participation unless the delegation has informed the organisers before the group draw or in the case of force majeure. The latter instance will require the approval of the ISF Steering Committee.

6.2 The ISF Secretariat is responsible for registering all deposits before 30th November 2010.

6.4 The balance may be paid in cash, in EUROS, on arrival in Primiero (bank and credit cards will not be accepted), or may be paid in EUROS to the organisers' bank account at the latest 15th April 2011 as will be published in the third bulletin.

6.5 **All bank charges (for both deposit and balance) are to be met by participating countries.**

7. TECHNICAL RULES

7.1 The competition will be run according to current ISF and IOF rules under the direction of the ISF Technical Commission.

7.2 The maps will be drawn according to IOF Rules (scale 1: 10 000).

7.3 Punching system: SPORT IDENT.

7.4 Expected winning times:

Long distance:

Categories: expected winning time / max. distance

M1 boys born in 1994 and 1995	42 – 45 min.	6.500 m
M2 boys born in 1996 and 1997	32 – 35 min.	4.500 m
W1 girls born in 1994 and 1995	37 – 40 min.	5.500 m
W2 girls born in 1996 and 1997	30 – 33 min.	3.500 m

Middle distance:

Categories: expected winning time / max. distance

M1 boys born in 1994 and 1995	25 – 27 min.	4.000 m
M2 boys born in 1996 and 1997	19 – 21 min.	2.700 m
W1 girls born in 1994 and 1995	19 – 21 min.	2.700 m
W2 girls born in 1996 and 1997	19 – 21 min.	2.100 m

School teams and selected teams in each category will race the same distance on separate courses. The courses will be in the same area and will have different control points, this will result in courses of varying difficulty.

7.5 Classification of the teams:

For both races (Long and Middle distance), the classification of the teams will be made by adding the three best individual times of each race. The general classification will be done by adding the results of both races (Long and Middle distance). The winning team will be the team with the best result. When two teams achieve the same time, the team showing the best result on the Long distance will be declared winner. In the case of equal results, the best individual time of the Long distance run determines the winner. When both teams are again equal, the second time decides who will be declared winner and so on.

7.6 Prizes:

Team: 3 teams in every category, selected teams and school teams separately, will receive team prizes.

Individual; The first 3 in each category will receive medals. Additionally, the first 6 in each category will receive certificates.

7.7 Further details of technical regulations and competition formats will be annexed to bulletins 2 and 3.

7.8 The Friendship Team Event will be conducted in the spirit of the ISF in the form of mixed teams of boys, girls, from different participating countries.

8. REGISTRATION

8.2 The detailed entry bearing the names of all the players and other members of the delegation is to be returned to the OC by 15th April 2011 (detailed entry forms will be included with Bulletin 3).

9. COMMITMENTS TO BE HONOURED BY DELEGATIONS

- 9.1 Each participant is required to be present throughout the duration of the event.
- 9.2 Each participant is obliged to take part also in all of the non-sport activities.
- 9.3 Each team undertakes to compete against all other participating teams.
- 9.4 Each participant undertakes to compete against all other participants.
- 9.5 The absence of any member of a participating team from any part of the entire sport programme, opening-, prize-giving- and closing ceremonies and socio-cultural programme will result in the team being excluded from the results.

10. DOPING

Dope testing (for use of banned substances) can take place during the competition according to current law/procedures in Italy.

If selected for testing a competitor may be accompanied by an adult. If a competitor is following a course of medical treatment he or she must obtain certification to that effect and inform the organisers immediately upon arrival.
